There are two ways to participate in PD Days 2023: 1) Virtually - there will be ten virtual sessions (between 1-1.5 hours each) spread over the month of May, including a virtual keynote speaker; 2) In-person: there will also be an in-person full-day workshop held in Moncton on May 23rd, followed by an in-person networking event.

Important Notes:

- All virtual sessions will be conducted through Zoom. The Zoom meeting link will be sent to all registrants the day before each session. A reminder email will also be sent out the morning of the session.
- Unless otherwise stated, virtual sessions will be recorded and available to paid registrants through a password protected website until August 31, 2023. Session recordings will be available on www.pminbpddays.com within a few days of each session. The password for the site will be emailed to paid registrants.
- Even though the first virtual session will be May 1, the deadline for registration for virtual sessions is 5 pm on May 15, 2023. All paid registrants will receive all available session recordings.
